

EAGLES ADD FOURTH - AND FINAL - 'HOTEL CALIFORNIA' TOUR CONCERT IN NEW YORK

**ONE NIGHT ONLY
UBS ARENA AT BELMONT PARK
SATURDAY, APRIL 23**

**Show will Feature Live Performance of the Album In Its Entirety,
with Accompanying Orchestra & Choir, Followed by Full Greatest
Hits Set**

After selling out three shows in New York last year, the **EAGLES** - Don Henley, Joe Walsh and Timothy B. Schmit, with Deacon Frey and Vince Gill – have added a fourth, and final, ‘Hotel California’ Tour concert in New York, playing Long Island for the first time in 16 years. Tickets for the **Saturday, April 23** show for **UBS Arena at Belmont Park**, located seven miles from JFK International Airport on the border of Queens and Nassau County, go on sale on Friday, January 14 at 10 a.m. at Ticketmaster.com.

The show will begin at 8 PM featuring ‘*Hotel California*’ performed live in its entirety from start to finish, accompanied by an orchestra and choir. After a short intermission, the band will perform a set of their greatest hits.

A variety of presales are available starting Thursday, January 13th at 10 AM local time. Check [Eagles.com](https://www.eagles.com) for complete tour and ticket information.

A limited number of VIP packages will be available starting Friday, January 14th at 10 AM local. VIP packages include premium seats, exclusive merchandise, parking & more.

UBS Arena at Belmont Park is made for music and built for hockey. New York’s newest premier entertainment and sports venue and home of the New York Islanders is developed in partnership with Oak View Group, the New York Islanders, and Jeff Wilpon, with Sterling Project Development serving as development manager. Providing a significant boost to the regional economy, especially when economic activity has been greatly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, the world-class entertainment venue, with its timeless and classic design, bridges its iconic past with today’s advanced technology and amenities.

The \$1.1 billion multi-purpose, state of the art arena will host more than 150 major events annually while delivering an unmatched live entertainment experience including clear sightlines and premier acoustics. UBS Arena is designed to hold up to 19,000 people for concerts and around 17,000 for NHL games. In an effort to build a greener future, UBS Arena intends on being carbon neutral for operations before 2024, which will make it the first arena to do so on the eastern United States seaboard.

The Eagles kicked off the “Hotel California” concerts in 2019 in Las Vegas to rave reviews and critical acclaim. To date, the Eagles have performed more than 30 Sold-Out shows in 15 major U.S. arenas, including five nights at the famed Madison Square Garden in New York City, four nights at American Airlines Arena in Dallas, and three concerts at the Forum in Los Angeles.

Hotel California is the third best-selling U.S. album in history, certified 26-times Platinum by the RIAA. After its release in 1976, it topped the charts and won two GRAMMY Awards for "New Kid in Town" and "Hotel California." Several of the songs from the album have never been performed since the original "Hotel California" tour. The band's *Their Greatest Hits 1971-1977* is the best-selling U.S. album in history, with the RIAA certifying the collection at 38-times Platinum.

In today's faddish, fractured, rock landscape, the Eagles retain an appeal that transcends both generation and genre, cementing the band's role as enduring musical icons. As the best-selling American band of the '70s, and one of the top-selling acts of all time, the Eagles have sold more than 150 million albums worldwide, scored six #1 albums and topped the singles charts five times. They have won six GRAMMY® Awards, were inducted into the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame in 1998, in their first year of eligibility, and received the Kennedy Center Honors in 2016.

In addition to the Long Island Rail Road, the arena is also accessible via MTA Bus Routes Q2 and Q110 and the Nassau County Inter-Express N6 bus service.
