UBS Arena was awarded LEED Certified status in January 2023, a little over a year after opening to the public. LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design), developed by the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC), is the most widely used green building rating system in the world.

HOUSE KEEPING

CBS plays a crucial role in the planning and project strategy of the Zero Waste Initiative by determining the flow of waste, the process of sorting, and the labor estimated to handle the sorting per shift.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Delaware North has operated as the hospitality partner at the LEED-certified UBS Arena, since it debuted in November 2021. Delaware North oversees a local F&B program in which 75% of ingredients are sourced within a 300-mile radius of the arena. Delaware North has donated about 6,000 pounds of surplus food to local nonprofit organizations and partners with *Rock and Wrap It Up.* Even before UBS Arena opened, Delaware North forged supplier partnerships to ensure all drinkware, utensils and food vessels used at the venue are either compostable or recyclable.

This Resource Recovery Plant uses state-of-the-art technology to convert trash into fuel that creates electrical energy, this energy is then fed into the local power grid for local Long Island residents to use as electricity.
